WABC-TV Annual EEO Report February 1, 2022

This Annual EEO Report is filed on behalf of WABC-TV, New York, New York, in compliance with the FCC's EEO reporting requirements. WABC-TV, which is licensed to American Broadcasting Companies, Inc., serves a potential viewership of 20.3 million people living in the greater New York City region, New Jersey, and Connecticut. This report includes information from February 1, 2021 to January 31, 2022, and it will be placed in the station's public file, and on the station's website as of February 1, 2022.

WABC-TV is an equal opportunity employer and is committed to a policy that advances opportunities for all qualified individuals. It is our policy to promote the realization of equal employment opportunities through a positive, continuing program of specific recruitment, outreach, hiring, promotion, and other practices designed to ensure the full realization of equal employment opportunity.

To make this policy effective, and to ensure conformance with the requirements of the FCC, we have adopted an Equal Opportunity Program as described herein.

## **Job Vacancy Posting Practices**

As a general practice, in addition to internal dissemination, full-time job vacancies are posted on WABC-TV's public website at <a href="https://www.abc7ny.com/jobs">www.abc7ny.com/jobs</a> and on the public website of The Walt Disney Company at www.jobs.disneycareers.com. The Walt Disney Company, through wholly owned subsidiaries, is the parent company of American Broadcasting Companies, Inc., WABC-TV's licensee.

In addition, the station typically posts notices of full-time job vacancies on a variety of trade and community websites (see Attachment A) and usually sends them to various organizations on its mailing list. That organization list is attached as Attachment B. The mailing list is updated through monthly on-air advertisements and a posting at www.abc7NY.com/jobs inviting organizations that provide job information or referrals to contact us and place their names on our mailing list to receive notification of job vacancies.

In addition, the Disney-ABC Television Group Human Resources department has contracted with The Direct Employers Association to distribute notice of full-time positions to Direct Employers' network of hundreds of organizations that cater to students, alumni, veterans, minorities, disabled individuals, and individuals seeking employment information.

From February 1, 2021 to January 31, 2022, WABC-TV filled 21 full-time jobs. These job vacancies were publicly posted on www.abc7NY.com/jobs and on <a href="https://www.abc7NY.com/jobs">www.jobs.disneycareers.com</a>. Many were also posted or communicated in other ways, such as on websites listed in Attachment A, that varied according to the type of job. In addition, job vacancies were sent to all of the organizations in Attachment B. Those job vacancies were also sent to The Direct Employers Association for further distribution, as described above. See Attachment C for more recruitment details by position and candidate.

# **Record Keeping**

In compliance with EEO record keeping requirements, the station creates a file for each full-time position filled. Each of these files contains a summary sheet with the job title, the date recruitment started, the total number of applicants, what recruitment sources were used for each opening, the date the job was filled, and the source that referred the hired individual. Station procedure requires approval by the President and General Manager and the applicable Department Head prior to extending a job offer. EEO requirements and management responsibility toward EEO are discussed regularly at management meetings.

## **Supplemental Recruitment Activities**

In addition to the specific job recruitment efforts mentioned above, the station also engages in a variety of long-term initiatives designed to increase awareness of and develop qualifications for careers in broadcasting. During the reporting period, those included the following:

### 1. Job Fairs

#### NABJ Conference and Career Fair

NABJ (National Association of Black Journalists) is an organization of journalists, students and mediarelated professionals that provide quality programs, services, and advocates on behalf of black journalists worldwide. NABJ holds an annual convention and career fair each summer with sessions and workshops for professional development. This year's virtual event was held from August 18-21, 2021. VP of Community Engagement and Development Marilu Galvez represented WABC-TV.

# NAHJ Conference and Career Fair

NAHJ (National Association of Hispanic Journalists) is an organization dedicated to the recognition and professional advancement of Hispanics in the news industry. It also holds an annual convention and career fair. NAHJ holds an annual convention and career fair each summer with sessions and workshops for professional development. This year's virtual event was held from July 12-17, 2021. VP of Community Engagement and Development Marilu Galvez and Eyewitness News Anchor David Novarro participated in the first OTV Storytellers Summit in partnership with ABC News. VP of News, Rehan Aslam, Eyewitness News Anchor Joe Torres and Associate Producer Community Engagement and Development Chanila German represented WABC-TV in the career fair.

#### **AAIA Conference and Career Fair**

AAJA (Asian American Journalists Association) is an organization of journalists, students and media-related professionals that provide quality programs, services, and advocates on behalf of Asian American journalists. AAJA holds an annual convention and career fair each summer with sessions and workshops for professional development. This year's virtual event was held in from August 24-28, 2021. VP of Community Engagement and Development Marilu Galvez represented WABC-TV

The Association of LGBTQ Journalists (NLGJA) is an organization of journalists, media professionals, educators and students working from within the news industry to foster fair and accurate coverage of LGBTQ issues. This year, they hosted a Virtual Convention and Career Fair from September 9-12, 2021. VP of Community Engagement and Development Marilu Galvez represented WABC-TV.

Rutgers University – The Spring SC&I Virtual Career Fair for undergraduate and graduate students at the School of Communication & Information was held on February 12, 2021. Associate Producer Community Engagement and Development Chanila German and EP-Digital Innovation, Content & Strategy Rolando Pujol represented WABC-TV.

<u>St. John's University</u> – The Virtual Career Fair took place on April 15, 2021. Assignment Editor Omar Rodriguez and Associate Producer Community Engagement and Development Chanila German represented WABC-TV.

Hiring Our Heroes Career Fair Town Hall – WABC-TV (with ABC Owned TV Stations) partnered with Hiring Our Heroes and Disney Veterans Institute for a virtual career fair Town Hall which was streamed across all 8 OTV Stations on August 19, 2021.

- 2. Internship Programs WABC-TV sponsors an internship program aimed at third and fourth year college students who attend school in the tri-state area. The purpose of this program is to enrich and supplement the education of local college students in the field of television. Although the program is open to all, we place special emphasis on seeking out and identifying female and minority students who are majoring in broadcasting. During the reporting period, the station had a total of 28 interns. For a list of participating schools see Attachment D. Students can apply online with the assistance of Disney Campus Recruitment and get interviewed by various department managers. Students gain first-hand experience at a television station and can also receive college credit. These internships also help students develop relationships with industry professionals who may be of assistance to them in their future careers. They often assist in finding employment in similar markets.
- 3. <u>Intern Speaker Series</u> In the Spring of 2021, WABC Web EP & OTV Digital Project Manager, Bob Monek and KABC Local Brand Solutions Manager Lilian Pena developed an Intern Speaker Series to give interns an opportunity to network and learn from leaders across the ABC Owned TV Stations and The Walt Disney Company the following employees spoke about their careers and work at ABC/Disney:

4. Emma Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media Scholarship Program – WABC-TV is one of many communication companies that participated in this program which was developed to enhance the presence of minorities in the media by giving minority youth work experience during high school and college that will qualify them for jobs in the media. At the end of their third or fourth year of high school, students identified and chosen by the program on the basis of academics, recommendations, interviews and commitment to the program, enter the employment of WABC-TV. The student will have summer employment and possibly employment while school is in session, in addition to help with college expenses for the remainder of the student's college years. WABC-TV is responsible for exposing the student to a broad range of education, training and experience needed to qualify the student and help them advance to management and executive level positions in the future. WABC-TV employed one student from Montclair State University at the beginning of the reporting period.

5. Mentoring Programs - This is a one-on-one mentoring program with LaGuardia High School in New York City dedicated to reducing school drop-out rates among inner city girls and helping them to attain their goal of attending college. The program runs October through June and the mentors spend 6-8 hours a month with their mentee, and contact their mentees via phone or email at least once a week. Candy Martinez, Associate Director/Stage Manager, participates in the program and is the Coordinator for the ABC/Disney/ESPN Mentoring Program. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this program was conducted virtually during the period of this report.

WABC-TV participates in job shadows, career days and events, speaking engagements in the Community throughout the year.

These were limited in the period covered by this report due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
